37-year-old Israeli prodigy, Kira Radsinsky, can predict the future. And in the case of Dr. Kira Radinsky, prodigy, she started university at 15, earned her PhD at 26 and founded two start-ups on the side.

Dr. Kira Radinsky is the CEO of Diagnostic Robotics, where the most advanced technologies in the field of artificial intelligence are harnessed to make healthcare better, cheaper, and more widely available.

Dr. Radinsky has founded SalesPredict, acquired by eBay in 2016 and served as eBay Chief Scientist (IL). She gained international recognition for her work at the Technion {Hebrew for Institute of Technology} and Microsoft Research for developing predictive algorithms that recognized the early warning signs of globally impactful events, such as disease epidemics and political unrests.

She is a frequent presenter at global tech and industry conferences, including TEDx, Wired, Strata Data Science, Techcrunch and publishes in HBR. Dr. Radinsky also served as a board member in Israel Securities Authority and technology board of HSBC bank, and today serves on the board of Esh Digital Bank. She also holds a visiting professor position at the Technion focusing on the application of predictive data.
